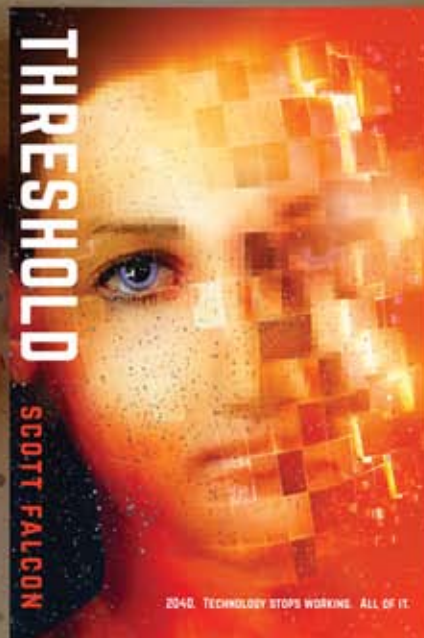
She believes the intelligence can create a cure, but her father intends to use radical technology. They are running out of time.
